



## The Five Steps to Get to Phil's Supermarket in Second Life (SL).

1. Log onto <http://www.secondlife.com>
2. Click *Join Now* in the upper left hand corner of your screen. Follow the prompts to...
  - a. Choose your avatar's name
  - b. Pick the look of your avatarYou will be asked if you want to upgrade to a premium account. You can choose skip this step.
3. A screen will appear confirming your new avatar name and Second Life will send you a confirmation email. In the email, click on the link to activate your account; then download the program to your desktop.
4. Double click the Second Life icon to open the program and sign in. When you arrive in SL you'll land on Help Island\*. Now you can walk around. Use the arrow keys to walk to the right and left, forward and back.

\*When you land a box or "HUD" appears on the screen, right click on it and select detach. It will disappear. If you are on a Mac, use the apple key for right clicking.

5. Click the search button at the bottom of your screen and a large box will appear. Notice the tabs across the top. Select the "all" tab and type Phil's into the search box. When the Phil's Supermarket appears in the list, select it. Now select 'teleport' in the lower right hand corner of the box and you'll magically land at Phil's Supermarket. Welcome! Come on in.

These Second Life terms will come in handy:

SL	Second Life
RL	Real Life
Inworld	Anytime you're logged into Second Life, you're inworld.
Linden \$	Inworld Monetary Unit of Exchange
Avatar	Your personalized inworld representative
Resident	Your avatar is a resident of the SL Community
Inventory	The collection of clothing, objects, textures, etc. your avatar possesses inworld. Your inventory travels with you, and you can use any of it at any time.
Landmarks	Instant teleports to specific locations stored in your inventory
Notecards	Information in SL is passed to you on notecards. You will find the file in your inventory.
HUD	Heads Up Display ("HUD") Attaches to your Second Life Screen. Useful for keeping information present on the screen, or accessing frequently used commands. (This is important because a HUD appears on the screen when you land on Help Island. Right click on it and detach it.)
